## **RULES FOR TOURNAMENT**

- 1. Entry fee: \$30.00 (\$12.00 bowling, \$15 prize fund, \$3 for expenses). Prize fund will be returned 100% at a ratio of at least one prize for each 5 entries. Expenses paid by Lancaster 600 Club.
- 2. Three game series all games bowled on same pair of assigned lanes.
- 3. Certified and governed by USBC rules. Any decisions to be made during the tournament will be decided by Lancaster 600 Club officers.
- 4. Bowlers must hold a current USBC membership card and be a member of their local 600 Club.
- 5. 85% handicap of the difference between entering average and 230. Scratch and handicap prizes will be awarded. Errors must be reported within 24 hours.
- 6. Entering average is the highest certified final average for the 2023-2024 season. If no average for 2023-2024, use 12 game average as of November 1, 2024. If no 12 game average, bowler must enter with average of 230. Rule 319a.2 (10-pin rule) will not apply. Rule 319a.3 will apply to all entries (average used). All winner's averages will be verified. Rule 319d (reporting of prize winnings) and 319e (average adjustment) will not apply.
- 7. Prize lists and checks will be distributed by the Lancaster 600 club within 30 days of end of tournament. Prize fund returned 100%.
- 8. Walk-ins are permitted until squad capacity is filled. Check-in time is 30 minutes prior to squad time. Late bowlers will start in frame being bowled and receive zero for missed frames.
